**COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN**

**THE "DIMITRIE CANTEMIR" CHRISTIAN
UNIVERSITY
OF BUCHAREST ROMANIA**

AND

The "Dimitrie Cantemir" Christian University of Bucharest Romania, represented by, Prof. *Corina Adriana Dumitrescu*, Ph.D, Rector,

and

The University of.....,
represented by, Prof..... Rector,

hereby called "the Parties";

Considering the initial agreement to start a cultural, scientific, and educational cooperation in the fields of mutual scientific interest;

Agree under the following conditions:

Article 1

The Parties agree to promote initiatives aimed at achieving joint research programs in scientific areas of mutual interest and at promoting cultural exchanges in the areas of training, education and scientific research.

Article 2

The Agreement defines the beginning of co-operation between the Parties in all fields and disciplines of mutual interest. It will be completed by additional protocols to define specific educational and scientific cooperation issues, rules of procedure and liability, as well as expected results.

Article 3

The cooperation envisages the setting up of joint research performance and teaching programs, based on:

It will be performed as follows:

- ✓ exchanging teachers, researcher workers, administrative staff and students;
- ✓ performing joint research projects of mutual interest;

- ✓ exchanging information, scientific works and teaching materials of mutual interest;
- ✓ joint initiatives, such as seminars, lectures, conventions etc.;
- ✓ giving free access to the facilities and research equipment of both institutions.

Article 4

Within the limits of regulations in force in each country, the Parties agree to find the necessary financial means to reach the above-mentioned objectives.

Article 5

The present framework Agreement shall be in force for a 5 year period from the date of the last signature by the Legal Representative of one of the Parties.

Any amendments will be notified in written by any Party with the approval of the other.

At the end of the 5 year period, the framework agreement will be automatically renewed, unless 6 months before the expiry date one of the Parties notifies to the other Party the decision not to renew it.

Article 6

The present framework Agreement includes equivalent texts, consisting of two original copies.
